**CAMPING:\*\*** **MIDWEST TRAIL RIDE.** For campsite reservations please call 812-834-6686.  
 The Midwest Trail Ride camp is a premier horse camp that offers primitive sites, electric sites, bunk houses and cabins to rent. Website for camp is [www.midwesttrailride.com](http://www.midwesttrailride.com)  
 Daily camping fees for the Maumee Endurance Ride to be paid directly to Midwest Trail Ride.  
**PLEASE NOTE:** When making reservations, be sure to say you are with the endurance ride to receive the 10% discount. The following reflects the 10% discounted fee:  
**Primitive Camping** - \$10 per person w/horse, all extra people without horses in primitive campsite are \$5.00. (kids under 6, no fee). Primitive price does not include a stall. You will be directed where to park. No pens in parking area, in front of bunkhouses or around the round pen. No pens larger than 12 X15.  
**Electric Sites** - \$17.55 per person, youth \$13.05, (kids under 6 years, no fee), site includes electric, covered stall and bedding, extra stalls \$10.00, extra people who are non-riders in electric sites \$8.55, non riding youths are \$3.05  
**Cabins and bunk houses are also available** - Call for reservations and availability.  
*All camping fees include campsite, use of the shower house, coffee and iced tea.*

**FOOD:** Snack Bar will be open Saturday and Sunday morning.

**TERRAIN:** The trails in Hoosier National Forest offer a wide variety of terrain and scenery from rolling hills to wide forest trails with some graveled forestry roads. Shoes are recommended. Tom Keith will be available as the farrier. **Daily bridle tags are \$5.00 and are available for purchase when you arrive. (Riders 16 and under are exempt)**

**VET-IN/START:** Vet in begins at 3p Thursday for Fridays ride and 3p Friday for Saturdays ride; Ride will begin at dawn both days.

**AWARDS:** Completion awards to all who finish meeting ride criteria and following all ride rules.  
 Top 10 awards in the 50 Endurance; Top 5 awards in the 25 Endurance; Top Juniors for both distances.

**DIRECTIONS:** **DO NOT USE GPS OR INTERNET AS THEY MAY TAKE YOU DOWN NARROW GRAVEL ROADS AND ACROSS NARROW BRIDGES.**  
**From the North** - In Indiana on I-65, exit at Columbus turning West on Hwy 46 toward Bloomington. Then turn South on 446. 7 miles after you pass over Lake Monroe, you'll see a Lawrence County sign on your right, Hunter's Creek Rd is the next street on the left, turn left here and then take an immediate right, camp is about a 1/2 mile on the left.  
**From the South** - In Indiana on I-65 exit at Seymour turning West on Hwy 50. Turn North on Hwy 446, go 8 miles and Hunter's Creek Road will be on the right. Turn right and then take another immediate right, camp is about 1/2 mile on the left.

**ENTRY FEES:** **\$5 DISCOUNTED ENTRY FEE IF POSTMARKED BY MAY 3RD, NO DEPOSIT REQUIRED:**  
 50 Miles (Friday & Saturday) = \$85\*      \*\*\* Juniors 50 Miles = \$45\*  
 25 Miles (Friday & Saturday) = \$65\*      \*\*\* Juniors 25 Miles = \$35\*  
 15 Mile Novice Ride (Saturday only) \$25, Juniors \$10, Completion award to all who finish.  
 (No time limits but will need to pass vet check and be "fit to continue").  
 No pre-entry required for Novice ride.
